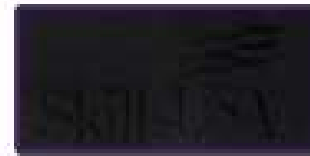
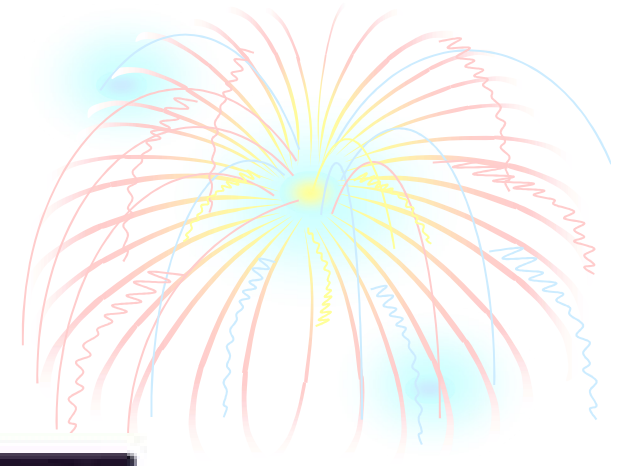
# Official SkillsUSA Attire
