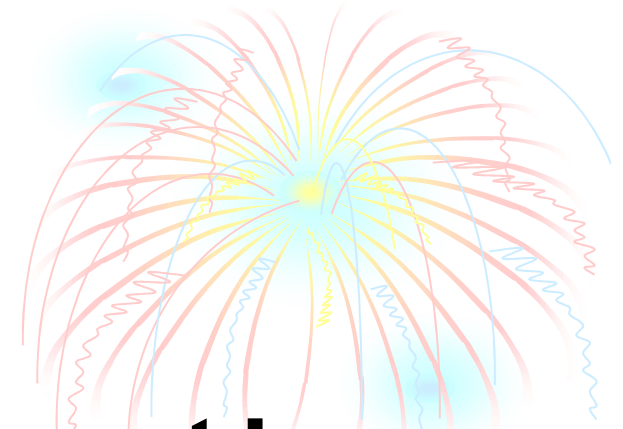

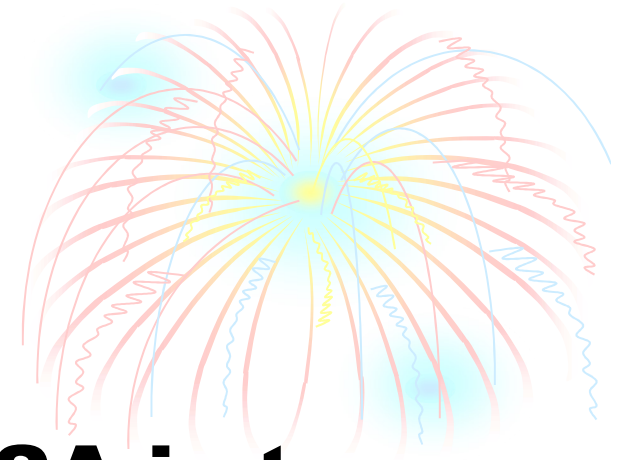


# Some of the Purposes of SkillsUSA

- **To foster a deep respect for the dignity of work.**


# Some of the Purposes of SkillsUSA
