Safety Review

- Half the workers injured on the job are **new** employees.

Safety Review

- People who work in shops need to protect three things:
 - vision/eyes
 - hearing/ears
 - head
 - hands

Safety Review

- Always wear your **safety glasses** whenever you're in the shop. Even if you aren't doing anything, other people are.

Safety Review

- NEVER put/place tools in your pockets.

Safety Review

- DON'T **distract** people who are working.

Safety Review

- ALWAYS roll loose sleeves to your **elbows** and **tie back/put up** long hair.

Safety Review

- ALWAYS cut **away** from yourself, when using chisels and other edged tools.

Safety Review

- Carry sharp tools and pointed tools **close** to your body with the points **down**.

Safety Review

- The following fire extinguishers fight which types of fires.
 - Class A: ordinary combustibles such as wood and paper.
 - Class B: flammable liquids like grease, gasoline and oil.
 - Class C: electrically energized fires.
 - Class D: flammable metals.

Safety Review

- Sawdust is **slippery/flammable** and should be cleaned up immediately.

Safety Review

- . After using a machine, ALWAYS stay with it until it comes to a **complete stop**.

Safety Review

- ALWAYS wear **hearing** protection when working with power tools or other noisy machinery

Safety Review

- NEVER use a machine without its **safety guard** in place.

Safety Review

- ALWAYS have the instructor's **permission** before operating any machinery.

Safety Review

- Before using a machine, make sure all the movable parts are properly **secured**.

Safety Review

- NEVER work with power tools or machines when you're **tired** or in a **bad mood**.

Safety Review

- Cut wood has **splinters** and sharp **edges** which can cause cuts and punctures.

Safety Review

- A metal edge can be just as **sharp** as the tools that cut it.

Safety Review

- Store tools and materials **flat/horizontal**, with the points and the heavy ends **down**.

- **EVERYONE** is responsible for safety!
