1. One-Half Inch, $\mathbf{1 / 2 "}$.

Example:

2. One and one-half Inches, 1 1/2".
3. Two and one-half Inches, 2 1/2".
4. Three and one-half Inches, 3 1/2".
5. Four and one-half Inches, 4 1/2".
6. Five and one-half Inches, $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
