

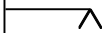
Drawing Measurements

Half Inches

A. Draw a horizontal line five times for each measurement listed, beginning at the vertical line and ending at an ending point ("v"), that are the exact lengths of the measurements listed.

1. One-Half Inch, $1/2$ ".

Example:



2. One and one-half Inches, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

3. Two and one-half Inches, $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

4. Three and one-half Inches, 3 1/2".

5. Four and one-half Inches, 4 1/2".

6. Five and one-half Inches, 5 1/2".
